NHS


Twenty one juniors were inducted into the Amesbury Chapter of the National Honor Society on Tuesday night in the auditorium.



NHS Advisor Dr. Walsh then led the inductees in the NHS pledge, followed by the usual group photo.






















Girls' Tennis
