







Anger" by Oasis but, his all time favorite artist is Kanye West. If the movie Austin Powers in Goldmember came


on, Ben would be the first person to grab a seat! Yet, if he could spend money in any store, it would Toys R

# TRACK TEAMS SPLIT

## BOYS TRACK

When going against a team using the Tigers as a mascot, some mauling is always bound to happen; on December 30th, during Christmas break, the Redhawks mauled the Tigers with a win of 67 - 33. I'm not one to ever make a joke with the former score, but any reader will know.

However strong of a landslide win, the meet seemed much closer for the majority of its duration. Starting the meet, the Tigers swept our boys in the 55 meter hurdles and took second place and third place in the 55 meter dash, leaving the infield races with a score of 5 - 13 in Ipswich's favor.

In the long jump, though, our guys got back: Noah Blouin, Joe Puleo, and Jayden Davis jumped for a clean sweep of the event, taking back the lead. Followers of the column might be curious to the distance of Blouin's jump: an unremarkable nineteen feet three-and-a-half inches. With a three-event load for the guy, his failure to jump for the record isn't really something we can blame him for, and I'm sure he'll be jumping back into my heart by the next meet.

In another field event sweep, Marcus Colon, Lucas Ferreira, and Jack Harrington brought home the bacon in the shot put. Colon dipped below 50 feet with his throw of 49' 2.75", yours truly had a red-letter day with a season best throw of 41' 11.75", and Harrington fell back into his old mid-30s consistency with a throw of 37' 7.25". With the state relays coming up on January 16th, all eyes are on Harrington to get back in the 40s with his throws. If you're reading this, Jack, know that expectations of you are high.

In the last field event of the day, Connor Scialdone and Brodie Hall jumped for first and third in the high jump. Scialdone was two inches below his personal record with a jump of 5' 8", and Hall leapt for a regrettable 4' 10". In remarks after the event, Hall was enraged, and rightfully so: in practice just before the feet, he had jumped higher with bare feet.

After sweeping the one mile and the two mile, there was no

real competition remaining. The Tigers hadn't even fielded runners for the distance events, so the worries of our guys on running without Josiah Fugate was ultimately unfounded. In the closing actions of the meet, a runner-error had our Redhawks disqualified from the 4 by 400 meter relay, but it didn't even matter: our guys were already flying high, and there just weren't enough events left for the Tigers to make a fight for the lead.

Next up for the guys is a meet facing Manchester-Essex on this upcoming Tuesday, January 13th. No real competition is incoming in that one, but a real trial will be on the 16th when the boys go down to the Reggie Lewis Center for the Division 5 State Relays. All wishes going forward are for fast times, long throws and jumps, and glory. If I was the casual track observer, I'd be looking forward to seeing Ben Wood's return next week. He's a real weapon for the team--had he run in the 55 meter dash against Ipswich, he would've come first by a long shot. A lingering hamstring injury has kept Wood off the oval thus far in the season, though, and his return is not guaranteed next week.





Since the start of winter break, the Amesbury-Whittier hockey team has won three of five games and has a record of 6-3.

The Redhawks beat Rockport 7-3 on December 20th, lost to Melrose 2-3, beat Beverly in overtime 4-3 on December 29th, lost to Methuen 2-3 on December 30th, beat Lynnfield 3-2 on January 3rd, and beat Triton 6-2 on January 7th.

The team is a co-op team with Whittier. In recent years, the team has been dominated by Whittier players, but Amesbury is holding their own with this years team. Both captains are Amesbury students, Lincoln Kime and Evan Murphy, both juniors. Ryan Guertin and Logan Genuardo are the other juniors. Thomas McElaney is the only Amesbury senior. Amesbury is also represented by sophomores Jacob Noyes, Tom Puorro, and Jack Kusler. Freshman Jack Puorro rounds out the Amesbury contingent.

In the Methuen game, Evan Murphy scored despite the loss, and Tom Puorro had a goal and an assist in the Lynnfield game. Amesbury met Triton this past Wednesday They play North Reading at the McVann-O'Keefe rink in Peabody tomorrow at noon.







# NOT A GOOD START

## Boy's Basketball (Continued)

The Amesbury High School boys basketball team has faced a challenging opening stretch to the 2025–26 season, currently holding a 1–4 overall record. They entered the season with essentially the same cast of characters, and even the same captains, as last year. The Redhawks began the year with a 42–69 road loss to a tough Manchester-Essex team, followed by a pair of competitive home defeats (51–59 against Georgetown and 58–54 against Ipswich) games that remained within reach into the second half, but slipped away late. This followed a similar pattern to last year, when Amesbury lost 6 games by tight margins. Amesbury then traveled to Stoneham, where it fell 52–70.

The Redhawks picked up a 56–46 home win over Hamilton-Wenham, earning its first victory of the season last Saturday. This contest was essentially, or literally, tied for most of the game, until the Redhawks pulled away at the end. That win highlighted improved defensive effort, better ball movement, and contributions from multiple players. However, they are still relying on Parker DeLong, last year's MVP, for points. DeLong scored 27 points. Chase Linsey had 13 and Justin Dube had 9. Amesbury meets Lynnfield tonight.






