
SAC chairperson Addi Snow called the event another successful winter

There were also an assortment of wooden jig saw puzzles, which





## Senior Profile



The Redhawks lost two of those three games and somehow moved up to 26th place, setting up a preliminary tournament game scheduled for this past Tuesday against 39th ranked Hampshire Regional. Since that game was snowed out, the game was then scheduled for last night after our deadline.

On February 12th, the Redhawks


faced Lynnfield at home. For a while Amesbury was ahead in this game, but the Pioneers pulled away at the end and won 75-69. This was a hard fought game. Amesbury scored 18 points in the 4th period, 14 of them foul shots. Parker DeLong had 26 points. Justin Dube had 20 and Ollie Peters had 13.

In a rare Sunday game on February 15th the Redhawks met Whittier for the second time. This was a better performance from Whittier than their previous meeting, but the Redhawks still eventually

won 75-63. Justin Dube had 14 points, Ollie Peters had 14, and Parker DeLong had 25, including his famous 1000th point.

On Monday, February 16th, the Redhawks lost to Stoneham 61-57. This game was actually tied in the fourth period and could have gone either way. Justin Dube with 20 points and Chase Linsey with 18 were the standouts of this game.

The regular season ended 8-12.











## Winter Track

### BOYS' TRACK

Since last time, the boys have gone to two meets: the Division 5 Championship and the Meet of Champions. With our small team size, the same kind of idea that was at play in the CAL Open meet applied heavily to both: we just don't have a large enough team to take enough points to win. There were standout performances in both, however, and those should not go unrecognized.

Starting with the Division 5 Championship, on February 14th, the boys came in 13th place out of 40 schools. Joe Puleo logged a speedy 6.853 seconds in the 55 meter dash, but did not advance to finals. Puleo saw a similar performance in the 300 meter, where his 36.72 second time did not advance him to finals. On a more successful note, Maxx Rodrigues took home a new school record in the 600 meter with a time of 1:27.09. Rodrigues had promised all season to break the record, and it was fitting that he did it in his last meet of the year. Though the guy says he won't come back to race for the Redhawks in the outdoor season, we're all hopeful he has a sudden change of heart. Over in the throws, Jack Harrington had a great day, throwing 45' 0.5" for a new personal record. Harrington has really put in the work this season, and it's definitely something to be proud of.

In the Meet of Champions, only Marcus Colon and Josiah Fugate attended. Colon took home fifteenth in the state in the shot put, while Fugate landed 11th in the state for the 1000 meter.

### GIRLS' TRACK

The Saturday before break, or more familiarly, Valentine's Day, was less about love and more about running and jumping for a certain group of six girls this year. The Division 5 Indoor Track and Field State Championship was held at the Track at New Balance in Boston, Massachusetts. The qualifiers: junior Hope Shanahan (55m dash, 300m, 4x400m relay), sophomore Katie Bigos (high jump), senior captain Haley Jezowski (two mile), senior captain Della Hildt (4x400m relay), junior Lexi Desmond (4x400m relay), and junior Lauren Talbot (4x400m relay).

Despite some confusion over the start time of the meet, the girls were optimistic and race day ready with dreams of PRs and medals. Katie Bigos was able to achieve this feat by jumping 5'02" in high jump, once again impressing us all, and Haley Jezowski managed to set a twenty-two second personal record to secure eighth place in the two mile. With three events on her plate at a state meet, Hope Shanahan had one of the most spectacular performances by running sub-eight seconds in the 55m, setting a personal record in the 300m, and finally coming back to anchor the 4x400. The 4x400m relay finished without the medal they deserved, but their running does not go unrecognized (shoutouts to Lexi, Della, Lauren, and Hope for being so speedy)! This may have been the last meet of the season, but you won't miss us for long; Spring Track is back in just a few short weeks.








